# The Challenge of Accountable Systems

Organizations have obligations regarding the collection, use, and sharing of information.

How can we ensure these obligations are met?

# Our Prototype Solution

Automatically produce a justification that explains compliance or non-compliance for each transaction

# Implementation Outline

- Encode laws into a machine-usable format
- Ensure that necessary databases are accessible
- Annotate each data-sharing event with metadata
- Enable a reasoner to process each event
- Display the justification in a user-friendly format

# Encoding Laws

A criminal justice agency may request this information from the Central Repository or another criminal justice agency only if it has a need for the information:

(1) In the performance of its function as a criminal justice agency; or

(2) For the purpose of hiring or retaining its own employees and agents.

# User Profiles

Subject to the provisions of Regulation .12B, the Central Repository and other criminal justice agencies shall disseminate CHRI, be it conviction or nonconviction criminal history record information, to **a criminal justice agency** upon a request made in accordance with applicable regulations adopted by the Secretary.

# Auxiliary Records

**The board shall certify those agencies and individuals requesting access to criminal offender record information** that qualify for such access under clauses (a) or (b) of this section, and shall specify for each such agency or individual certified, the extent of its access.

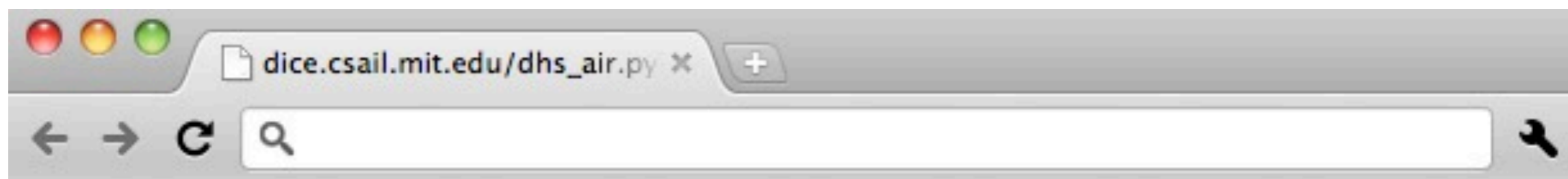

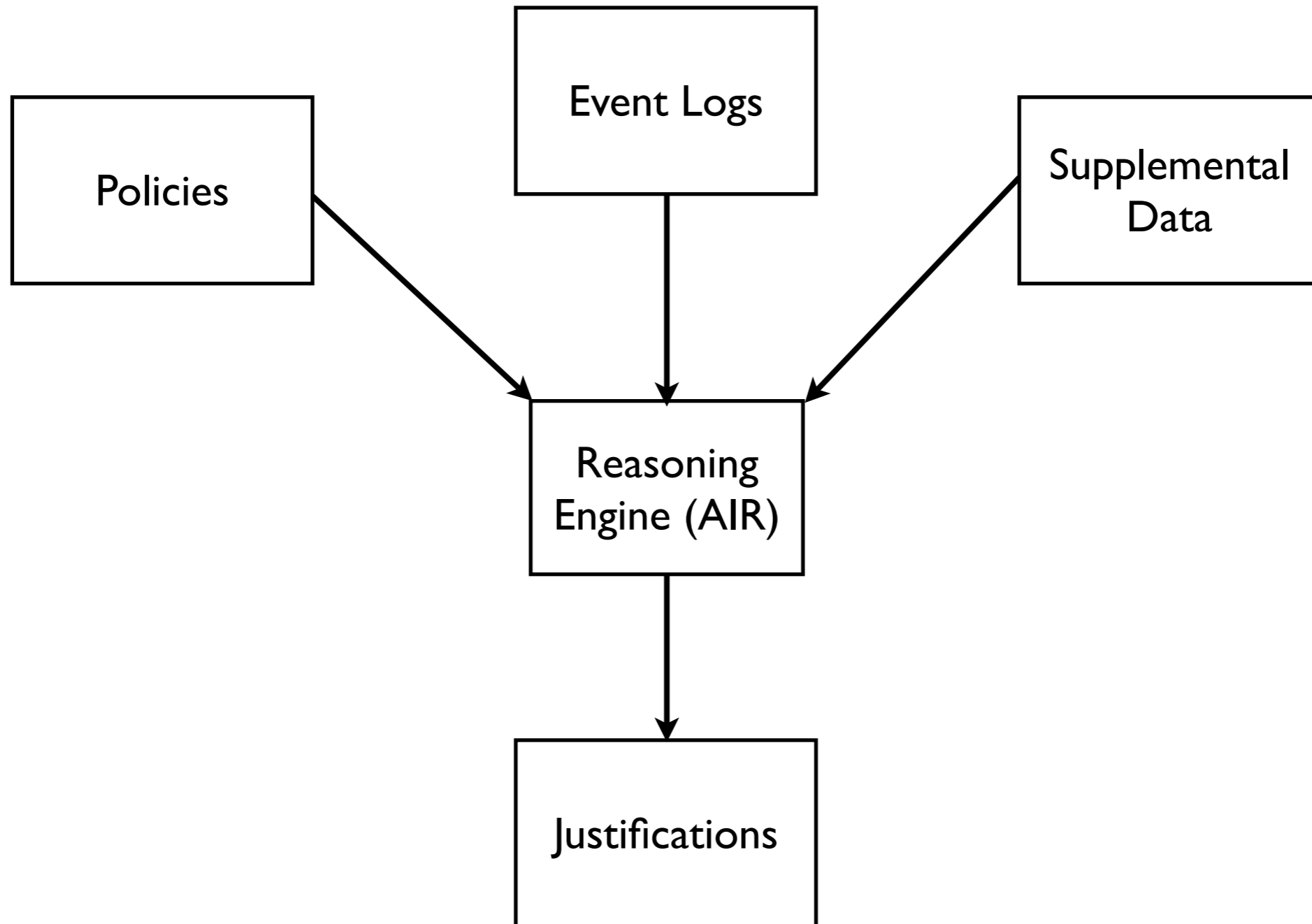

- Has Mia Analyssa demonstrated to Maury Copp that delay in receiving Fake\_MD\_Response.pdf will violate or materially impair a substantive right of the person about whom Fake\_MD\_Response.pdf is needed?

# Displaying Successful Justifications

## ▼ Analysis:

- [Fake\\_MD\\_Response.pdf](#) has been verified by [Central\\_Repository](#) to be complete, accurate, and current.
- [Fake\\_MD\\_Response.pdf](#) is required for [Mia Analyza](#) to hire or retain employees and agents.
- [Mia Analyza](#) is a [Maryland Criminal Justice Agency](#) . [Transaction](#) is a dissemination request from [Maury Copp](#) to [Mia Analyza](#) .
- If [Transaction](#) is compliant, it is compliant only if [Transaction](#) is made in accordance with applicable regulations adopted by [Secretary](#) .
- [Mia Analyza](#) demonstrated to [Maury Copp](#) that a delay in the receipt of [Fake\\_MD\\_Response.pdf](#) will unduly impede necessary action by [Mia Analyza](#) .

## ▼ Conclusion:

The transaction - [Transaction](#) is compliant with [MGL\\_12\\_15\\_01\\_11](#)

# Displaying Failed Justifications

## ▼ Analysis:

- If [Transaction](#) is compliant, it is compliant only if [Transaction](#) is made in accordance with applicable regulations adopted by [Secretary](#) .
- [Mia Analyza](#) is a [Maryland Criminal Justice Agency](#) . [Transaction](#) is a dissemination request from [Maury Copp](#) to [Mia Analyza](#) .
- [Maury Copp](#) cannot disseminate [Fake\\_MD\\_Response.pdf](#) to [Mia Analyza](#) because it is neither required for its function as a criminal justice agency or for the purpose of hiring or retraining employees and agents.

## ▼ Conclusion:

The transaction - [Transaction](#) is non-compliant with [MD\\_12\\_15\\_01\\_11\\_Ab2](#)

# Additional Benefits

- Experiment on old events with new policies
- Run hypothetical transactions against many policies
- Profile the usage of existing policies

# Challenges

- Vocabularies between organizations may not match up
- Translations of laws may differ
